61 training sessions attended by 180 staff

100% of course attendees rated our courses as Excellent or Good overall . (89% rated them excellent)



27% of library skills training attendees were allied health professionals, 23% doctors, 34% nurses and midwives



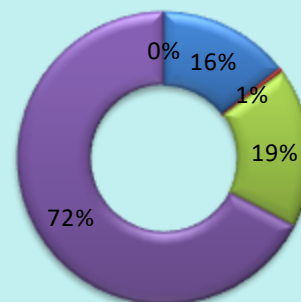
72% intend to use the skills learned during library skills sessions for Research / Professional Development / Education
