Library skills training sessions impact 2018/19

71 training sessions attended by **148** staff



“This is an ideal course and every clinician intending to do literature search this is a must do to enhance searching skills.”



100% of course attendees rated our courses as Excellent or Good overall . (**86%** rated them **excellent**)



30% of library skills training attendees were allied health professionals, **40%** doctors, **27%** nurses and midwives

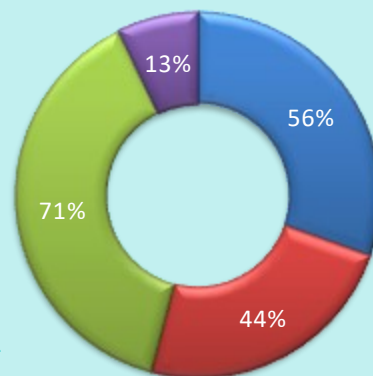


59% intend to use the skills learned during library skills sessions for **Research / Professional Development / Education**
